* that number of residents (DNV+CNV) increased 4.7% so more vehicles/person

Also from Canada Census: (see attachments)

* Population growth in DNV from 2006 to 2011 was 2.2%

* Population growth in DNV from 2011 to 2016 was 1.8% (lower growth than above)

* Total private dwellings: 31,741 (2011) 32,624 (2016) an increase of 2.8%

So: number of units growing faster than population - means that people/unit must be decreasing (2.66 people/unit in 2011 to 2.62 people/unit in 2016)
